 Bishop of Brooklyn



Bishop DiMarzio was installed as the Seventh Bishop of Brooklyn, which encompasses the Boroughs of Brooklyn and Queens in New York, on October 3, 2003. In addition he is currently a Member of the Vatican's Pontifical Council for the Pastoral Care of Migrants and Itinerant People and past Chairman, Migration Committee of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, as well as the past chairman of the Catholic Legal Immigration Network, Inc. Board and a past Chairman of the Finance Committee of Catholic Relief Services. In 2011, he was appointed a member of the board of trustees for The Catholic University of America. He is also, currently Chairman of the Board of The Center for Migration Studies of New York, Inc. Bishop DiMarzio has spent his ministry of over 40 years in the areas of immigration assistance and refugee resettlement services. He has served as both an advocate for refugees and immigrant concerns in political forums, and as the initiator and administrator of programs to assist refugees and immigrants both within the U.S. and in many countries throughout the world.
